Admission: All participants will have hands stamped for free admission, plus directors and two adults per band. **All daytime performances are free and open to the public.**

Evening Concert: After the last band performs, the auditorium will be cleared and people may re-enter with tickets.

Tickets will be given to band students on Saturday. Students may return Saturday night at their convenience. Tickets for the public are \$6. The concert is from 7-9:15 and will feature the University of Indianapolis Jazz ensemble, Honor Jazz Band, and Directors’ Jazz Orchestra with our guest artist Mike Tamaro.
