Each opportunity below pays to your marcher's personal account! 10% goes to the general fund with the rest directly funding your marcher's fees. Money raised can be transferred to Music Travel during trip years after your band fees are paid in full for the season. Simply reach out to Student Accounts and ourTreasurers to facilitate this. All opportunities will have an event specific signup genius and info sent out via BandApp and Cuttime.

Lucas Oil Opportunities

- Eligibility: Ages 16+ can work. A valid liquor permit is required for anyone 21+ in alcohol sales roles.
- Pay: earn at least \$160 plus tips per event. Tips are split per person in the stand.
- Roles: Alcohol sales require a licensed person (21+) to run the register. Nonalcoholic events can have 18+ nonlicensed individuals run the register.
- Event Duration: Colts games and concerts typically last around 8 hours. Other events may vary. Parking is free in specified lot.
- Dress Code:
 - Black dress pants (no jeans, leggings, holes, or ripped pants)
 - Black t-shirt (long or short sleeves, no sleeveless)
 - All black shoes (preferably tennis shoes, no sandals or open-toe shoes)
 - Hat/visor (preferably a Fishers Tiger Band hat)

Indiana State Fairgrounds – Urick's Concessions

- Eligibility: Ages 16+ can work. A valid liquor permit is required for anyone 21+ in alcohol sales roles.
- Pay: Ages 16+: \$15/hr and Licensed adults: \$17/hr. Tips are split evenly per person.
- Hours: Vary per event.
- Parking: A Parking Pass will be issued via email and must be shown on your phone at the gate. Specific gate information will be provided in an email.
- Dress Code:
 - Black dress pants (no jeans, leggings, holes, or ripped pants)
 - Black t-shirt (long or short sleeves, no sleeveless)
 - Tennis shoes (any color, no open-toe shoes or sandals)
 - Hat/visor (preferably a Fishers Tiger Band hat)
- Signups for events coming out asap!



Conner Prairie Museum

- Eligibility: Ages 14+ can work. A valid liquor permit is required for anyone 21+ in alcohol sales roles.
- Pay: Youth (14+): \$10/hr and Adults (18+): \$12/hr. Tips are split between licensed adults.
- Dress Code: Held outdoors, so dress code varies with the weather.
 - Pants or appropriate length shorts
 - T-shirts (no sleeveless shirts)
 - Closed-toe shoes
 - Hat required
- Event Schedule: Typically starts at the end of June with Symphony on the Prairie and runs through the end_of December with Merry Prairie Holidays/Breakfast with Santa.

Trash Bags

This one is easy and anyone can do it. Sell trash bags to anyone who needs some! 5 different styles/sizes are available for purchase. A stock is carried so most orders can be picked up/delivered right away. Rolls cost \$13 each with \$3.50 going to your students account and \$1.55 going to the general fund. Simply fill out the trash bag order form and email it to trashbag@fishersband.org.

How to Obtain Your Liquor Permit:

- Visit the Website: Go to Indiana ATC Online Services <u>https://www.in.gov/atc/atc-online-services/</u>
- 2. **Apply for Permit**: Click on "First time applicant" or "renewal" under the Employee Permits section. Sign up and apply for the Volunteer Employee Liquor License. The cost is \$15.
- 3. **Complete Mandatory Class/Video**: During your application, you will be prompted to watch and pass a mandatory class/video. This can be found under the Education tab in the menu to the left.
- 4. **Carry Both Documents**: Ensure you have both your liquor permit and the certificate from the mandatory class with you when you volunteer at any of the mentioned locations.
